Purpose: To allow a freestanding sign to have an overall height of 9'3" whereas the maximum height permitted is 8' in the Residential High-Density Zone "RHD"; and

To allow a freestanding sign to have an overall square footage of 114 square feet whereas 48 square feet is the maximum permitted.
